A number of years ago at the church I was then serving, our Children and Youth Director, Linda Ketchie, offered the devotion at the beginning of a Church Council meeting. It wasn't a Bible lesson, as is what I generally would do. But, I believe it was founded in Scripture just the same. The title of the reading is *Ministry or Job?*, and while I don't know the name of its author, I truly wish that I did. I am grateful to them. It is a lesson each Christian needs to be reminded of from time to time, including and especially me.

Ministry or Job?

Some people have a job in the church. Others invite themselves into a ministry. What's the difference you ask?

- If you are doing it just because no one else will, it's a job. If you are doing it to serve the Lord, it's a ministry.
- If you quit because someone criticized you, it's a job. If you keep on serving, it's a ministry.
- If you'll do it as long as it does not interfere with your other activities, it's a job. If you are committed to stay even if it means letting go of other things, it's a ministry.
- If you quit because no one thanked you or praised you, it's a job. If you stick with it even though no one recognized your efforts, it's a ministry.
- It's hard to get excited about a job. It is almost impossible not to get excited about a ministry.
- If your concern is success, it's a job. I your concern is faithfulness and service, it's a ministry.
- If God calls you to a ministry, don't treat it like a job!

Linda then closed with this prayer: "Lord, strengthen your servants and move us to a true sense of ministry and service, through your grace and mercy. Amen."

There isn't much I could add. In fact, I'm sure I couldn't have said it any better than this. I'll simply close by saying that, knowing that we are to be a priesthood of all believers, we need to ask ourselves to which ministries God is calling us. Perhaps we each need to try several to find the right one. There is nothing wrong with trying many tasks to find the one that fits your gifts.

Doing nothing is never the right answer. Doing nothing doesn't mean you aren't called. It may simply mean you've stopped listening to God.




Dry Bottoms Ministry Update




The Pass Along Box
